DORMITORY

DORMITORY with food services: KENSRI DEGREE COLLEGE has established separate hostels for boys and girls in a secure residential neighborhood.

A full-fledged, well managed kitchen is attached to these hostels. Our chefs are known for their multi cuisine culinary talents. In-house wardens are the custodians of hostels who ensure smooth functioning of the hostels. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the hostel as well as in the college. Spacious dining halls are maintained within the premises to provide dining facilities to all the inmates of the hostels. Students have access to telephones within the hostel. Wardens are available in the hostel premises at all times to manage and take care of students.

Two to three students are accommodated in each room with attached bathrooms. Hostel rooms are well ventilated and adequately lit. Telephones with intercom / call transfer facilities are provided. Well-trained security staffs provide security to our hostel students 24 hours, round the clock. Each student is provided with a steel cot, study table, chair and cupboard.

TRANSPORTATION

1. As per RTO our school buses are installed with CCTV, GPRS and lady attender. As per the availability of the number in the bus the students will be accommodated in a school bus. We believe in first come first service, students who are already travelling in school bus will be given priority.

2. Transport will ply on specified routes daily.

3. We request you to inform the transport manager if any change in address and phone numbers.

Transport to arterial routes will be provided during the evenings and weekends as 4. per the requirement. Transport can be used only those who subscribe to school transport.

5. The school management will not be dealing with private transporter.

Transport fee should be paid in two installment, the due dates will be 10th May 6. and 10th November of the academic year. Payment by DD in favour of KENSRI TRANSPORT if it's not paid on time child will not be allowed to travel in the school transport

Once the payment is cleared, the child will get a bus pass which has to be shown to 7. the drivers at the time of boarding into the bus. The surprise checking will happen from the admin department, in case if we come to know the child is travelling without the bus pass will be charged . ₹100/- per time. The parents who are willing to clear the full year transport fee can be done and the bus pass will be is issued which is valid for the year.

8. Transport facility will be cancelled if the fees are not paid on time.



ANTI-BULLYING

KENSRI School is committed to providing an educational environment for all students,

employees, and volunteers that is safe and civil and free from harassment, intimidation or bullying. Harassment, intimidation or bullying (HIB) behaviors refer to any gesture, any written, verbal, cyber or physical act, that is reasonably perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristics, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristics, whether or not the act occurs on or off school grounds that has the effect of substantially disrupting or interfering with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students and that:



A student victim, the parent/guardian of a student victim, a close adult relative of a student victim, or a school staff member who wishes to report an incident of alleged harassment, intimidation, or bullying, must write a note in the School Annual diary and get it to the notice of the SDS.

In cases where the administration determines that an act has occurred, counseling, corrective discipline will be used to change the behavior of the perpetrator and remediate the impact on the victim. False reports or retaliation for harassment, intimidation or bullying will also result in disciplinary action.

DROPPING OFF ITEMS FOR CHILDREN

- If your child forgets to bring something to school, you will still be able to drop off the item. However, entry into the school for the sole purpose of dropping off an item will be prohibited.


